- All easels, tables, chairs, tents and other supplies required will be the responsibility of the participant and will not be provided by the Abbotsford Arts Council.
- Participants are responsible for their own set up and take down of materials. Visual artists must remain within eye sight of Kariton Gallery and at least 8 feet away from the walking path.
- Participants will be encouraged to fill out an evaluation form after taking part in the event
- All participants are required to register in advance of the event.
- Parking is limited. To keep the parking lot free for patrons, please unload your materials and then move your vehicle.
